- 6. PARENT DROP-OFF: Ensure that all children are ready to practice without interruption. You are responsible for any restroom breaks before and during practice. Our coaches cannot leave practice to accommodate this request. If your child requires additional assistance we ask that you remain onsite during the full practice time. (Flag cheer and Football Parents MUST remain at practice at all times)
- PARENT PICK- UP: Our coaches are required to stay until the last child is picked up however we ask that all parents work with us to ensure that they are at practice and games 20 minutes prior to the scheduled end to ensure on-time pick up.
- 8. LET THE COACHES COACH: Leave the coaching to the coaches on the field. This includes motivating, mentally preparing your child for practice, after game critiquing, setting goals, additional training, etc.
- NEVER ATTACK WHEN YOU ARE ANGRY: If you have an issue, follow-up with any board member, coach or team mom after 24 hours. This will give everyone a chance to cool down and support positive dialogue.
- 10. **HAVE FUN:** We will challenge your child to reach their potential and improve themselves as a player and a person. We will attempt to do this in an environment that is fun and challenging.
